**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARING RFP FOR ON-DEMAND MOBILITY SERVICE (MICRO-TRANSIT) TO BEEFREE, LLC D/B/A FREEBEE, THE HIGHEST RANKED, RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED, EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$487,453) PER YEAR FOR THREE YEARS PLUS TWO ONE YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

17           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,  
18 Section 23-5, Competitive procurement required, Procurement Mechanisms. (a), all  
19 purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services in excess  
20 of the delegated spending authority, shall be based on a competitive procurement  
21 process and Section 23-9 Award, (e) while the City Manager may award procurements  
22 within delegated spending authority, all other procurements, except emergency  
23 procurements, require commission approval for award; and

25           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends a cost-effective and scalable mobility solution  
26 by delivering on-demand micro-transit services that optimize operational efficiency  
27 while expanding transportation access throughout the City, and by leveraging shared  
28 ride technology and dynamic routing, the service will reduce operating costs per  
29 passenger trip compared to traditional fixed-route expansions, while maximizing  
30 coverage and flexibility; and  
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32           **WHEREAS**, the proposed implementation of micro-transit is expected to  
33 increase ridership, improve first-mile/last-mile connectivity, reduce traffic congestion  
34 by decreasing reliance on single-occupancy vehicles, and support environmental  
35 sustainability goals by lowering greenhouse gas emissions and improving overall  
36 system efficiency; and  
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38           **WHEREAS**, on January 22, 2026, the City of Hallandale Beach released RFP  
39 25-26-07, On-Demand Mobility Service (Micro-Transit); and

41           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to  
42 be in the public interest to award RFP 25-26-07, On-Demand Mobility Service (Micro-  
43 Transit) to BEEFREE, LLC d/b/a Freebee, the highest ranked, responsive and  
44 responsible for a not to exceed amount of Four Hundred, Eighty-Seven Thousand,  
45 Four Hundred and Fifty-Three Dollars (\$487,453) per year for three years plus two  
46 one year renewal options, and to authorize the City Manager to execute relating  
47 documents.
