11	WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Section 23-4, of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of		
12	Ordinances, Competitive Bidding Required, provides that all purchases of and contracts for		
13	equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost exceeds \$50,000,		
14	shall be based on competitive bids, and pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of		
15	Contract, the City Manager shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission		
16	award of contracts; and		
17			
18	WHEREAS, since 2018, the City of Hallandale Beach has provided mobile parking		
19	services to its residents, visitors and business community through downloaded mobile		
20	applications (apps), and seeks to offer users the additional option to pay for parking without		
21	the need to download a mobile app through a simple texting service; and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, on March 5, 2025, the City of Hallandale Beach released RFP # FY 2024-		
24	2025-13 Parking Mobile Payment Services seeking multiple parking app providers, as		
25	follows:		
26	1. RESIDENT / PERMIT SERVICES: to provide a mobile app service to accept		
27	payments for parking on an hourly & monthly basis. The same firm shall be used to		
28	facilitate hourly & monthly discounts to Hallandale Beach residents and the		
29	appropriate permit holders.		
30	2. NON-RESIDENT SERVICES: to provide mobile app service to accept payments for		
31	parking on an hourly basis to non-residents of Hallandale Beach.		
32	3. PAY-BY-TEXT: to provide 'pay-by-text' service for parking on an hourly basis to		

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non-residents of Hallandale Beach.

WHEREAS, Staff recommend awarding Service Category #1 exclusively to
PayByPhone, the second ranked bidder. This vendor is familiar to residents since August
2018. Given the minimal point differential between the top two rank, staff recommend
avoiding the cost to the City of transitioning to a new service and avoids any potential
interruption in service; and

WHEREAS, for Service Category #2 – Non-Resident Services, Staff recommend a shared award to both PayByPhone and ParkMobile, each of which currently serves non-resident users. PayByPhone has provided these services since August 2018 and ParkMobile since August 2024. Both platforms are familiar to the City's visitors and business community, enabling a smooth transition to the new contracts without disruption to the user experience; and

WHEREAS, for Service Category #3 – Pay-by-Text Services, Staff recommend awarding this category to ParkMobile offering added convenience to users who prefer not to download a mobile app.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize award of RFP # FY 2024-2025-13 Parking Mobile Payment Services to the vendors as indicated herein and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute agreements consistent with the RFP and variance requests, if any, approved by the City, and should negotiations with the recommended firms be unsuccessful, authorize release of a new Request for Proposal.

Service Category #1 exclusively to PayByPhone.

Service Category #2 to both PayByPhone and ParkMobile.

Service Category #3 to ParkMobile.
