SECTION 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Adoption of Tentative Millage Rate. The Chair and Board of Directors hereby adopt and establish the proposed millage rate for FY 2026-2027 at 1.0934 mills which is \$1.0934 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the Golden Isles Safe Neighborhood District.

SECTION 3. The Establishment of date, time, and location of public hearings. The date, time, and place of the first and second public hearings on the proposed millage rate and budget; are set by the Chair and Board of Directors as follows:
