INCLUDING SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 13 AND ALL 8 ELEMENTS THEREOF, TO INCORPORATE REVISIONS IDENTIFIED THROUGH THE CITY'S EVALUATION AND 9 APPRAISAL REPORT (EAR) REVIEW PURSUANT TO 10 SECTION 163.3191, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR 11 TRANSMITTAL OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TEXT 12 AMENDMENT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163, FLORIDA 13 STATUTES, PART II, ("COMMUNITY PLANNING ACT"); 14 **PROVIDING FOR** CONFLICT; **PROVIDING** 15 **FOR** SEVERABILITY: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE 16 DATE. 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature intends that local planning be a continuous and ongoing process; and 20 WHEREAS, Section 163.3191, Florida Statutes directs local governments to assess 21 22 the success or failure of the adopted Comprehensive Plan to adequately address changing 23 conditions and state policies and rules every seven (7) years; and WHEREAS, Section 163.3191, Florida Statutes directs local governments to adopt 24 25 needed amendments to ensure that the Comprehensive Plan provides appropriate policy guidance for growth and development; and 26 WHEREAS, on August 15, 2018, the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") adopted 27 28 Ordinance No. 2018-19, thereby adopting the Evaluation and Appraisal Report (EAR)-based 29 amendments; and 30 WHEREAS, the City has completed its proposed amendments consistent with the 31 requirements of the Community Planning Act pursuant to Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes; and 32 WHEREAS, the City has determined that minor amendments are required to maintain 33

the Comprehensive Plan's consistency with Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes, and

35 36	prepared the amendments for transmittal to the Florida Department of Commerce for review; and
37	WHEREAS, on July 15, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Board serving as the Local
38	Planning Agency, considered the EAR-based Comprehensive Plan amendment at a duly
39	noticed public hearing; and
40	WHEREAS, on, the City Commission approved the proposed
41	amendments on first reading for transmittal to the Florida Department of Commerce; and
42	WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Commerce and other reviewing agencies,
43	including the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the South Florida Water
44	Management District (SFWMD) completed their review of the proposed amendments and
45	issued official comments in a letter dated known as the Objections,
46	Recommendations and Comments Report; and
47	WHEREAS, Section 163.3191, Florida Statutes requires that the local governing body
48	adopt the Evaluation and Appraisal Report-based Comprehensive Plan Amendments by
49	ordinance no more than 180 days from the date that the Florida Department of Commerce
50	issues its Objections, Recommendations and Comments Report; and
51	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have conducted duly noticed public
52	hearings on the proposed amendments to the City's Comprehensive Plan, as required by
53	Chapter 163, Florida Statutes; and
54	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the proposed
55	amendment is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents and hereby
56	adopt this ordinance.
57	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
58	OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
59	Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are
60	confirmed as true and incorporated herein.
61	Section 2. Approval of EAR-Based Amendments. The Mayor and City Commission
62	of Hallandale Beach, Florida hereby approve the Hallandale Beach EAR-based amendments
63	as incorporated herein as attached "Exhibit A" to include various updates of definitions,

objectives, and policies, consistent with Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes. The 64 amendments also include various corrections addressing the Florida Department of 65 Commerce Objections, Recommendations and Comments Report. 66 67 Section 3. Transmittal. The Comprehensive Plan as hereby amended shall be transmitted to all appropriate reviewing agencies as provided in Section 163.3184, Florida 68 69 Statutes. 70 Section 4. Conflict.
