WHEREAS, CCNA firm Hazan and Sawyer has proposed to provide design and construction services and startup of the Reverse Osmosis (RO) Skid No. 2 (P2510) Project for a not-to-exceed design fee of One Million, Fifty-Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred and Thirty-Two Dollars (\$1,059,732), which services will include the design, permitting, bid assistance and construction administration for connecting the membrane building to existing City Well Nos. 7, 8, and 9 raw water piping, interconnect to accommodate future piping from Floridan Aquifer wells and sand separators, RO skid of 2.0 MGD capacity with feed pump and appurtenances, cartridge filter and interconnecting piping in the membrane building; and

WHEREAS, the Opinion of Probable Cost for construction provided by the design professional is Six Million, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,100,000); and
