4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
5 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
6 AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWELVE (12) LEVEL III
7 BALLISTIC SHIELDS, FROM FEDERAL EASTERN
8 INTERNATIONAL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-
9 EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY DOLLARS
10 (\$48,240); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section. 23-4, Competitive bidding required, of the Hallandale
13 Beach Code of Ordinances, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and
14 contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000.00, shall be based,
15 wherever possible, on competitive bids, however the city manager is authorized to purchase
16 and contract for equipment, supplies and contractual services when the cost does not
17 exceed \$50,000.00 without further city commission approval; and

19 **WHEREAS** the Police Department ("HBPD") seeks to purchase twelve (12) Level III
20 ballistic shields to protect HBPD officers, enable faster movement and give officers the ability
21 to directly confront a threat, minimizing both the chance of injury and the potential for further
22 damage; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the purchase of Level III ballistic shields is an officer safety issue and is
25 in the interest of the City, and Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission
26 authorize the purchase of twelve (12) Level III ballistic shields from Federal Eastern
27 International in the amount not to exceed forty-eight thousand two hundred and forty dollars
28 (\$48,240) during Fiscal Year 2022-23; and authorize the City Manager to execute all related
29 documents.

31 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
32 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**
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34 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
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SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the purchase of twelve (12) Level III ballistic shields from Federal Eastern International in the amount not to exceed forty-eight thousand two hundred and forty dollars (\$48,240) during Fiscal Year 2022-23; and authorize the City Manager to execute all related documents.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
