4 5	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
6	AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO PAY AN UPGRADE
7 8	COST TO THE FDOT FOR DECORATIVE LIGHTING POLES IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND,
9	THREE HUNDRED, AND TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS
10 11	(\$66,324); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN
12	EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, of the City Code of Ordinances, the City Manager's
16	purchasing authority for services is \$50,000.00, with items over \$50,000 requiring City
17	Commission approval; and
18	WHEREAS, Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") Project 446997-1 is
19	an intersection lighting retrofit project to enhance pedestrian safety at 9 signalized
20	intersections in Broward County, along State Road 5/US-1. The goal of the project is to
21	install new light poles and/or modify existing poles to achieve FDOT's lighting criteria. In
22	general, light poles are placed in advance of crosswalks to better illuminate pedestrians;
23	and
24	WHEREAS, FDOT's proposed conventional light poles and lights do not match the
25	existing decorative poles and lights within the City limits. However, decorative poles carry
26	an additional cost to the City. Should the City Commission decided to proceed, a Locally
27	Funded Agreement (LFA) between the City and FDOT will need to be in place; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, on December 12, 2021, the City entered into a District Maintenance
30	Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) whereby the City agreed to maintain certain
31	roadway improvements. Such MMOA will need to be amended to include the proposed
32	decorative lighting within the limits of this project. The necessary amendment to the
33	current MMOA has been made a part of the proposed LFA; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find that it is
36	in the public interest and approve the proposed LFA with FDOT for decorative lighting
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37	poles in the amount of Sixty-Six Thousand, Three Hundred, Twenty-Four Dollars
38	(\$66,324), and authorize the City Manager to sign all related documents.

40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
41	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
42	CECTION 1 The foregoing "M/herees" elements incorporated herein
43	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
44 45	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize entering into an
46	agreement to pay an upgrade cost to the FDOT for decorative lighting poles in the amount
47	of Sixty-Six Thousand, Three Hundred, and Twenty-Four Dollars (\$66,324), and authorize
48	the City Manager to sign all related documents.

50	SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
51	adoption.
